Dear Parent/Guardian,

Your child is invited to participate in the Sumner County Sheriff's Office Summer C.H.A.M.P. (Character, Honesty, Attitude, Motivation, Positivity) Camp. The camp is **free** and open to 5th – 7th grade students. The summer program is for those students that have shown a positive attitude and a willingness to work with other students. Emphasis is placed on building a motivational spirit through teamwork, sportsmanship, community, and self-discipline, which allow youth to foster a positive relationship with law enforcement. Participants will be exposed to life skills, team-oriented games, community service, and an end of the week ceremony. The camp will be supervised and staffed by Sumner County Sheriff's Office School Resource Officers. The students who attend the camp must be able to provide their own transportation to and from camp each day. The camp hours will be from 8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday. Campers must arrive between 8:00 a.m. and 8:15 a.m. Campers must be picked up no later than 3:00 p.m. (No early drop-off or late pick-ups). The child must commit to **attending camp for the entire week**, as there is a limited number of slots.

Return the application to your School Resource Officer or School front office ASAP and no later than April 9, 2018. The slots will be filled on a first come first serve basis. If your child is selected to attend the camp, you will receive a phone call to verify their enrollment. So please ensure a good working number is listed. If your child is not selected, then they will be added to a waiting list in order applications were received.
